HUI 1 – Personalising Your Induction and Mentoring Programme

This workshop is designed specifically for the pro-active PCT and mentor. It will focus on what a quality induction and mentoring programme looks like, and how it can be personalised to highlight areas of importance in your teaching journey.

Learning outcomes:

Participants will build on their knowledge and understanding of Induction and Mentoring by:

- identifying key components of a quality induction and mentoring programme
- developing a personalised induction and mentoring plan
- developing a 'pro-active' attitude

HUI 2 – Standards for the Teaching Profession

Our Code, Our Standards puts a spotlight on our profession and how we should behave as teachers. This workshop is designed to look at the standards and how they interconnect and impact on each other.

Learning outcomes:

Participants will be supported to:

- build their knowledge of the Standards for the Teaching Profession
- utilise tools and templates to gather evidence to develop professional practice

HUI 3 – Evidencing the Good

Use tools and templates to unpack your daily practice, to analyse and plan next steps. This workshop provides the opportunity to work through your collected evidence and present in a professional portfolio that highlights your continued growth and development.

Participants will be supported to:

- curate evidence collected in professional portfolios
- plan next steps
